★ 2 Bryson City:

The Friends of the Marianna Black Library Bookstore is located at 32 Everett Street in an old historic building in the heart of Bryson City. Just a short walk from the Library, the Bookstore offers convenient parking, easy access and a great view of the Tuckaseegee River.

The store has a wide selection of used books including regional classics, some golden oldies and 1st editions, magazines, large print and audio books, DVDs, videos, compact disks, and children's materials, all donated and attractively arranged in well marked shelving. The Friends of the Marianna Black Library is an all volunteer organization dedicated to advocacy and financial support of the Library. The bookstore is beautifully organized with a large selection of almost new books of all categories from fiction, biographies, politics, business, literature and much

more to CDs, DVDs, reference materials, PC games, etc. The Bookstore has a large selection of fiction in hardcover as well as trade and mass market paperback. Gift Certificates are offered to our customers for purchase to encourage readers of all ages to come sample the variety and selection available. Proceeds from the bookstore support the Library in its various public events, computer area, and programs held in the Library. Friendly volunteers are there to assist you.

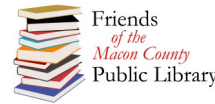

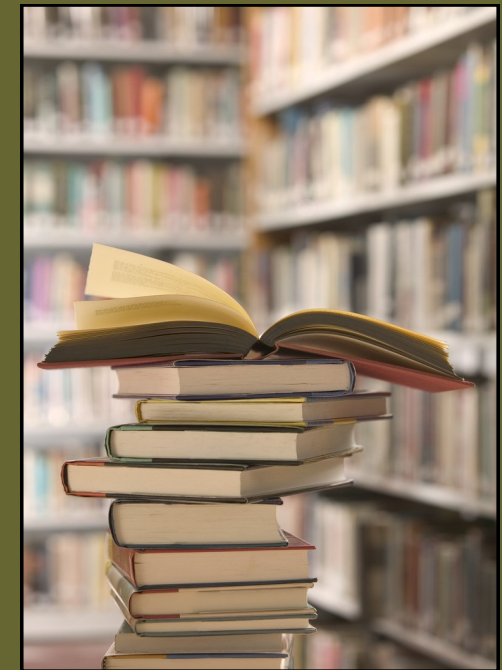
