Guidelines for Conduct

It is our intention to provide good library service in a pleasant environment. In order to do so, the following guidelines for conduct have been approved by the FRL Board.

- Treat people with courtesy and respect.
- Appropriate attire including shirt and shoes is required.

The following are not permitted in library buildings or on library property:

- Verbal abuse, threatening behavior, or other disruptive conduct towards others.
- Loud laughter or conversation which is disturbing to others.
- Food or drink, except water in a sealed container, or in designated areas.
- Damage, destruction, theft, or improper use of library property and materials.
- Selling, advertising, petitioning, or soliciting for contributions or support, except as authorized.
- Smoking or use of other tobacco materials, except in designated outside areas.
- Alcoholic beverages except as authorized.
- Engaging in any illegal activity or conduct.
- Littering.
- Weapons.
- Sexual misconduct.
- Animals, except with permission or an assistance animal.

Unattended children:

- No unattended children under the age of seven while the library is open.
- If children under the age of eighteen are left unattended after closing, police will be contacted.
