

## INFANT/ TODDLER BINGO

Make up a rhyme about a pet or family member	Share a book - add sounds and unique characters	Play Peek-a-Boo with child	Roll ball or other round object back and forth with child	Count to 5 or more using your hand or other objects
Dance to music with child	Sing and make animal sounds for "Old MacDonald had a farm"	Pick up items and count them as you put them into a container	Make rhyme words with child's name (silly words are okay!)	Share a book – point and ask "What's that?"
Sing and do actions to "Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes"	Play "I Spy" color game "I spy something ——"	Share a book – talk about the pictures	Pretend to be a vehicle – make its sounds and actions	Play "Pat-a-Cake" Game together
Go on a walk together. Stop & talk about what you see	i i nange characier i	FREE SPACE	Rhyme everyday words or objects ex. Spoon-Moon	Do a puzzle together
Share a book—use the pictures and tell your own story	Take an imaginary trip to child's favorite place	Sing and do hand motions for "Itsy bitsy little spider"	Read or say a nursery rhyme	Ask child to repeat phrase or rhyme
Show child how to make music with home items like pans and spoons	Draw a picture and then talk about it together	Inflate a balloon and tap it back and forth	Share a book—talk about colors on a page	Sing and do actions for "If you're happy and you know it"
Play "Monkey See, Monkey Do" ask child to copy your actions	Share a book—count objects on a page	Sing and do actions for "Where is Thumbkin"	Make up a story about your family with your child	Pretend you are an animal. Do its sounds and actions
Using child's doll or stuffed toy—name the parts of the body	Read or tell a folk tale Example: 3 Little Pigs	Sing and do actions for "Wheels on the Bus"	Play clapping game—ask child to clap hands like you	Share a book—try singing or chanting the story
