Why We Are Asking You to Feed Rover

"Rover costs \$52,000 a year to deliver its books and stories to children. That's over \$4,300 a month. The Rover receives funding from state, local, and grant funds, as well as generous donations from our Friends the Library groups and members of the public, like you. With the rising costs of fuel and vehicle mainte-

nance, as well as the increase in the cost of library books and education materials, it's is a challenge to keep the Rover on the road. We need your help to continue bringing this special service to the children in our communities."

The Reading Rover Bookmobile travels over 500 miles each month delivering quality early literacy materials and programming to just over 650 children in 70 preschool classrooms.
